DEAR NEW SONG KIDS VOLUNTEER

Welcome to one of the most important ministries in the church! You are now part of a team that has the privilege of showing kids what it means to have a real **encounter with Jesus**.

SECURITY POLICIES

"The Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore." Psalm 121:8

Security Guard

- An approved security guard must be present in the hallways whenever New Song Kids (NSK) classrooms are open.

Check-in & Name Tags

- All children must receive a printed name tag before entering a classroom.
- The parent/guardian must keep the matching security tag.
- If kiosks are unavailable, use a manual NSK name tag.

Roster

- Early childhood classrooms must use a door-side roster for check-in.
- Record all required information clearly and completely.
- Rosters serve as emergency contact and identification tools.

Room Access

- Only approved individuals with a completed background check may be in classrooms with children present. Please note that in NSK we are **NEVER ALONE WITH A CHILD**.
- **If any volunteer is found alone in a room with a child(ren), the volunteer can be immediately released.**



CHECK-IN & CHECK-OUT PROCEDURES

"For God is not a God of disorder but of peace..." 1 Corinthians 14:33

At Check-In

- Greet families warmly.
- Ask for special instructions or prayer needs.
- Ensure all roster details are complete.
- Label all belongings.

At Check-Out

- Begin prep before pickup: wipe hands/faces, organize bags, return personal items.
- Match parent tag before releasing any child.
- Always end with a positive note about the child's day.
- Only NSK staff may discuss challenging behavior with parents.

HEALTH & SAFETY POLICIES

"But all things should be done decently and in order." 1 Corinthians 14:40

Wellness Requirements

- Children and volunteers must be symptom-free for 24 hours (without medication) before attending. Stay home if experiencing any of the following:
 - Fever of 100°F or higher
 - Vomiting or diarrhea (past 24 hours)
 - Persistent cough, sore throat, or croup
 - Runny nose with colored mucus
 - Unexplained rash or skin infections
 - Pink eye or eye discharge
 - Head lice or nits

Allergies

- Food allergies (e.g., dairy, gluten) are listed on the child's name tag and classroom roster.
- All classrooms are peanut-free.



HEALTH & SAFETY POLICIES CONTINUED

Medication Policy

- Volunteers/staff may not administer any medications to children including creams, drops, or gels.
- Volunteers may not take medication in the classroom.

Emergency Protocol

Call 9-1-1 immediately and notify an NSK staff member if:

- A child is choking, unconscious, or seriously injured
- A child has trouble breathing (especially allergy-alert children)
- There's a fire or serious security concern
- **Please reference the Evacuation Plan posted in the classroom for further instructions on emergency protocol.**

Cleanliness & Hygiene

Volunteers must wash or sanitize hands:

- Upon entering the room
- Before preparing food or bottles
- After restroom use, diaper changes, or wiping noses

FOOD & DRINK POLICY

"So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God." 1 Corinthians 10:31

In the Classroom

- No hot beverages in the classroom.
- No food or drinks should be left within children's reach.
- All snacks must be peanut-free.
- Parents may provide snacks for their kids if the food is peanut-free.
- Please note the roster and name tags for any allergies prior to serving snack.



DiAPER CHANGiNG & RESTROOM POLiCY

"He tends his flock like a shepherd: He gathers the lambs in his arms and carries them close to his heart; he gently leads those that have young." Isaiah 41:11

Diaper Changes

- Only females age 17+ may change diapers.
- Both parts of the classroom door should be closed during diaper changes.
- Every child should be changed at least once per class or when soiled.
- Children in pull-ups are taken to the restroom and checked.
- Diaper Change Procedure:
 - Use the child's labeled diaper; if none, use a church-provided one.
 - Gather supplies (wipes, wax paper, gloves, stickers) before starting.
 - Use fresh gloves and paper for each child.
 - Clean the changing table between changes with disinfectant wipes.
 - Never leave a child unattended on the changing table.
 - Speak the Diaper Declaration over each child.
 - Seal and bag any soiled clothing before returning it to the diaper bag.
 - Please make note of any abnormal diaper contents on the classroom roster.

Children's Only Restroom Use

- Volunteers are never alone with a child in any restroom.
- Male volunteers are not allowed in restrooms with children.
- Doors must remain open when assisting a child in the Children's Only Restrooms.
- Let the child do as much as they can independently.
- If you notice an adult in the restroom, please notify NSK staff immediately.
- **Because we are NEVER ALONE WITH A CHILD, any volunteer found alone in the children's only restroom with or without a child(ren) can be immediately released.**

Children's Only Restroom Use

- Please use the restroom prior to your serve time in order to minimize disruptions from the classroom flow.
- If you experience an emergency and require a restroom break, please communicate with the hallway volunteer or NSK staff member so a solution can be arranged.



DRESS CODE POLICY

"Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship." Romans 12:1

General Guidelines

- A volunteer badge or lanyard must be worn at all times.
- Clothing must be modest, clean, and appropriate for working with children.
- Please avoid low-cut tops, crop tops, sheer clothing, or anything that exposes undergarments or midriff.
- Shorts and skirts must comfortably provide full-coverage.
- Avoid clothing with offensive or controversial images or slogans.
- A minimum of two inches-wide straps are required. No spaghetti straps/strapless tops.
- Please wear clothing that allows you to sit on the floor and engage in play with children. *We desire for kids and parents to feel safe, welcomed, and focused on Jesus—not distracted by what someone is wearing. If a staff member has a concern about your outfit, they will kindly let you know.*

CLASSROOM OPERATIONS

"Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters."
Colossians 3:23

Volunteer Requirements

- Minimum of two background-checked volunteers per room.
- One volunteer must be an adult female (18+ or approved).
- Volunteers must **never be alone with a child.**

Volunteer Expectations

- The focus of volunteers should be on the children at all times.
- Volunteers should never be in a laying position in the classrooms.
- No gossiping, complaining, or profanity - speak encouragement, life, and truth.
- Children may not sit on male volunteers' laps unless it is an infant being held.

Nursery Notes

- Babies should only sleep in the cribs or in a volunteer's arms.
- Only bottles that are pre-made by the parent may be given to a child and must be labeled with the child's name.
- Bottles should be served at room temperature unless a bottle warmer is approved.
- Always remain alert to signs of choking or discomfort.



BEHAVIOR & DISCIPLINE

"My son, do not despise the Lord's discipline, and do not resent his rebuke, because the Lord disciplines those he loves, as a father the son he delights in." Proverbs 3:11-12

Philosophy

- Discipline is handled with grace and understanding. Physical discipline is never allowed.
- Volunteers must always use encouraging, respectful words.

Unacceptable Behavior (Requires Immediate Staff Involvement):

- Biting, hitting, kicking, spitting, hair-pulling
- Verbal abuse
- Repeated defiance
- Severe tantrums or meltdowns

"Reset" Process

- **Behavior Reset:** "I see you're having a hard moment. You can try again or come sit with me."
- **Group Reset:** Sit with the child away from the group while maintaining connection.
- **Class Reset:** If behavior continues, notify a hallway volunteer or NSK staff member to contact the parent.

Volunteer Tone & Correction

- Always speak life over children.
- No yelling, shaming, or sarcasm.
- Praise good behavior, redirect as needed.

CRISIS & INCIDENT REPORTING

"God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble." Psalm 46:1

Serious Incidents

Immediately report the following to an NSK staff member:

- Injuries with visible marks, blood, or swelling
- Allergy-related exposures
- Injuries causing prolonged crying or limping
- With any concerning behavior or post-incident, complete an incident report at:

COMMUNICATION

"Instead, speaking the truth in love..." Ephesians 4:15

Behavior Communication

- Only NSK staff may contact parents (except during 9-1-1 emergencies).
- Volunteers must not communicate medical or behavioral issues to parents.

Abuse Awareness

- If you suspect physical, sexual abuse, or neglect, notify the department pastor immediately. They will report appropriately.

GENDER POLICY

"So God created mankind in his own image... male and female he created them." Genesis 1:27

We follow a Biblical understanding of gender. FAQs:

- Restrooms: No cross-gender use; family restroom is available.
- Clothing: Handled case-by-case—focus is on distraction level.
- Small Groups: Based on biological sex.
- Camp Dorms: No cross-gender dorms.
- Names/Pronouns: Preferred names may be used; pronouns must reflect biological sex.
- Acceptance: All children are treated with love and respect.

CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS
