This year, New Song Night Out carries a clear and compelling focus: our city.

Over the past year, we have seen significant momentum through Neighborhood Network, a sports-based outreach using basketball as a relational bridge to engage students and families across Oklahoma City. Through organized 3v3 tournaments, mentoring, and consistent neighborhood presence, meaningful pathways for Gospel-centered relationships are being established in communities where access, transportation, and opportunity are often limited.

What we are experiencing is growth.

What we now need is scalable capacity.

A primary goal of New Song Night Out 2026 is to secure transportation resources that remove barriers and expand our ability to consistently reach students, show up in neighborhoods, and steward long-term relationships. This investment represents a pivotal step in strengthening what is already bearing fruit in our city through the heart of basketball — loving our neighbor, loving our city, and loving the sport.

In addition to our city focus, New Song Night Out will also invest into:

NATION — Serving alongside Dream Center Esperanza in Puerto Rico

WORLD — Partnering with Fire & Fragrance South Africa to reach a college town with the Good News of Jesus
